Animal Surrender/Donation Policy

Policy

It is the policy of Trinity Horse Refuge to accept surrendered animals and donated equines from their owners.

Procedure

Trinity Horse Refuge accepts surrendered animals and donations of equines by owners who are unable or unwilling to provide a home for the animal for any reason, on a space available basis only.

Trinity Horse Refuge reserves the right to refuse surrendered/donated animals. Trinity Horse Refuge requires that all equines donated to the have all paperwork available for said equine, including medical records. Owners must sign a surrender/donation contract and must relinquish all rights to the animal.

At the owner's request we will provide updates and inform the owner of the animals progress.

Trinity Horse Refuge will determine if the animal is suitable for placement or will remain as a permanent resident. Animals surrendered or donated to Trinity Horse Refuge cannot be reclaimed by the former owner. A monetary donation from the owner will be requested, but is not a requirement.

Animals will receive all necessary care and will be evaluated, rehabilitated and retrained when necessary.
